TOPS IN THE LEAGUE: 17 Patriots have had their contracts' purchased in 2017: 12 by MLB organizations. LHPs Jeremy Bleich, Logan Darnell (twice) & Aaron Laffey along w/ RHPs Tyler Cloyd, Ryan Kelly, Vin Mazzaro, Mitch Atkins, INF Tyler Bortnick & OFs Jerry Sands, Christian Marrero and Justin Pacchioli had theirs' purchased this season. RHPs Scott McGregor and David Kubiak & LHP Rick Teasley (Taiwan), INF Olmo Rosario (2X, Mexico) also had theirs' purchased.

REVENGE SZN: Somerset looks to avenge last year's Liberty Division Championship Series loss to the Ducks, a series they were leading 2-0 after winning the first two games at home. Somerset defeated Long Island in five games in the 2015 Liberty Division Championship Series en route to a title.

HAMBURGER HELPER: RHP Mark Hamburger was named the Game 1 starter for Somerset after impressing in his only start as a Patriot. In the playoff opener, Hamburger earned the win after allowing just one run over seven innings.

ROLL AWAY YOUR STONE: Kyle Roller has reached base in 35 of his last 42 games (hits in 27-of-42). Over that stretch, Roller has 10 home runs, 41 RBI and 26 BB. Despite 90 games in the regular season, he ranked sixth in the league in home runs (22), T-sixth in RBI (77), T-eighth in BB (55) and led the league in OBP (.429), SLG (.591) and ranked third in batting average (.326).

BULLS IN THE PEN: Over the last 20 games, Somerset's bullpen has limited its opponent to just 25 earned runs over 85.1 innings (2.64 ERA).

WILL THE THRILL: Will Oliver struck out a team-high 13 batters in the Patriots' first complete-game shutout of year on 9/8. Oliver gets the nod as the Game 3 starter at home with plenty of playoff experience on his side. In Game 4 of the 2015 Liberty Division Championship Series against Long Island, Oliver threw a complete-game three-hit shutout to force a game five.

TICKLE ME OLMO: Olmo Rosario stayed hot at the plate in game one of the LDCS with a 5-for-5 performance with two RBI. Dating back to the regular season, Rosario has hit safely in 8-of-10 games, over which he is batting .528 (19-for-36) with five RBI and six runs scored.

BACK IN THE FOLD: INF David Vidal made his return to the Patriots on 9/12. The 2015 Atlantic League champion owned a .283 average with 38 home runs and 125 RBI in his previous two seasons in Somerset.

MALONEY NOT A PHONY: The Patriots boosted their offense by acquiring IF/OF Joe Maloney on 9/15. Maloney had a break out year in 2017 with Rockland of the Can-Am League, hitting a league-record 35 home runs in 99 games.

IT'S A TRAPP: Justin Trapp has a hit in 14-of-15, over which he is 28-for-65 (.431). Additionally, he has reached base in 29 of 33 games, over which he is 48-for-124 (.387) with one homer, 11 doubles, nine walks, 19 runs and 18 RBI.
